**GLENDORA, September 2, 2012** - In response to the Williams Fire that ignited earlier this afternoon and after consultation with local officials, the American Red Cross Los Angeles Region has opened a shelter at:

The fire has burned over 3,600 acres and is only 5% contained. The American Red Cross shelter will be open throughout the evening and until residents are allowed back to their homes.
