SPECIAL FOLLOW-UP MEETING TO DISCUSS POTENTIAL WATER-ORIENTED COMMERCIAL OR MIXED USE PROJECT FOR PARCELS 49 AND 77

MARINA DEL REY, CALIF. – Aug. 13, 2009 - The Department of Beaches and Harbors is

pleased to announce a special follow-up meeting scheduled for Tuesday, August 25 from 6-8

p.m., at the Burton Chace Park Community Center located at 13650 Mindanao Way, Marina

del Rey to discuss a potential project on Parcels 49 and 77.

The public is welcome to attend and present ideas on how to integrate the project with

a revitalized Chace Park and how to have both serve as a focal point for gathering, living,

shopping, and leisure activity for Marina del Rey and the surrounding areas.

The development parameters for Parcels 49 and 77 are: a) a water-oriented

commercial or mixed use project that may include up to 135,000 sf of visitor-serving

commercial uses with no residential units; b) up to 255 residential units with 116,495 sf of

visitor-serving commercial uses; or, c) up to 26,000 sf Department of Beaches and Harbors

Administration Building in the scenarios above.

The project must also maintain mast-up storage and boat/trailer parking spaces on

Parcel 49, a boat launch ramp on site, pedestrian access and bike path, and a dock for

storage and launching of small personal watercrafts such as dinghies and jet skis.
