BIRD WATCHING TOURS OFFERED FOR 2011 SEASON

Department of Beaches and Harbors will again offer its popular Bird Watching Program,

beginning February 24th. The program offers a free two-hour excursion through the Ballona

Wetlands and the shoreline habitat of shorebirds such as Sandpipers, Long-Billed Curlews,
