## **ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Dear Neighbor:

The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works is pleased to inform you of an upcoming roadway improvement project in your neighborhood.

Within the next few weeks, work will begin on Admiralty Way, Via Marina, Bali Way, and Mindanao Way (see map on the reverse side). The project, which will be built at no cost to the adjacent property owners, consists of the resurfacing of existing roadway pavement along Admiralty Way from Via Marina to Fiji Way, Via Marina from Washington Boulevard to Marquesas Way, Bali Way from Admiralty Way to Lincoln Boulevard, and Mindanao Way from Admiralty Way to Lincoln Boulevard. The project includes median landscaping and hardscaping enhancement along Admiralty Way and Mindanao Way within the project limits. The project also includes the installation of an additional left-turn lane along eastbound Admiralty Way at Bali Way and at Mindanao Way and will include the appurtenant traffic signal improvements. The work will be performed by All American Asphalt and is expected to take about 7 months to complete.

During construction, parking may be restricted and traffic will be delayed by large equipment and the delivery of materials to the jobsite. Temporary "NO PARKING" signs will be posted along the construction route at least 1 day prior to the arrival of the work crew to your area. Access to adjacent properties will be maintained by the contractor except for short periods of time when it is impractical to do so. If access is blocked temporarily, notification will be provided by the Contractor prior to the work. Traffic may be reduced to one lane in each direction along Admiralty Way, Via Marina, Bali Way, and Mindanao Way between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. There may be unavoidable periods where a shortened detour needs to remain in place overnight. Please observe all traffic controls, parking restrictions, and flagmen; and exercise caution while in the vicinity of all construction activities.

Throughout construction, Public Works will have **Ms. Brittany Barker**, Community Liaison, in charge of the project. She can be contacted at **(626) 458-4971**, Monday through Thursday, from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., for any questions or concerns that you may have about this project. Persons who are deaf or hard of hearing may make contact by first dialing the California Relay Service at 7-1-1.

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience the construction may cause. Thank you for your patience, cooperation, and understanding during the construction of this project. We hope that upon completion of this project, you will find it to be a great improvement to your community.


