Gentlemen：
Purguant to Section 77 of the Auministrative Code of the County of Los Angeles I submit herewith a statisti－ cal report covering the operation of the Coroner＇s Depart－ ment for the fiscal year 1942ームう．

The case load for this fiscal period shows 6831 deaths investigated as compared with 6760 durino the pre－ ceding fiscal year，and the operating cost of 13.83 per case is but ll centis more thon the unit aet cost during the preceding year，in spite of the fact that the cost of materials used was considerably higher．Our high standard of accuracy in determining the causes of death by autopsy was maintained although we had the services of but three autopsy surgeons instead of iour，as heretofore．

The chemical laooratory，placed in operation during this period，has already proven ain invaluable aid to the speed and accuracy of our fincings in cases where toxico－ logical examinations are incicated．

This office has suffered，as all other departments of county government，in loss of personnel due to the man－ power shortage caused by the war．It has been impossible to secure replacements for two autopsy surgeons who have joined the armed forces，one of which has been filled only temporarily．In other divisions of the office satisfactory replacements have been made and an earnest effort is being made to maintain the efficiency of the office at the high－ est possible level．
