The Violation Notice is a formal, written document sent to a parcel owner informing them that their property is in violation of the Los Angeles County Fire Code. A Request for County to Clear form, which includes an estimated clearing cost may be sent along with the Notice of Violation

 - 2. Roadways: Clear and remove all flammable or combustible growth for a minimum of 10 feet on each side of every roadway whether public or private. (F.C.317.10)
