SUBJECT: **CUSTODIAL CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE REVIEW FOLLOW-UP**

We have completed a follow-up review of the County's custodial services contractors with significant or major contract/labor law violations as identified in our February 22, 2002 report to your Board. The Second District requested the follow-up to determine if the contractors had corrected the violations.

Our review included interviewing County contract managers and staff and reviewing documentation provided to them by the contractors that indicated the violations had been corrected.

Background

On October 19, 1999, your Board instructed the Auditor-Controller, in conjunction with other County departments, to conduct audits of all custodial service contracts. In response, we conducted 25 audits (23 custodial contracts, one landscape contract and one cafeteria contract) and issued reports on each audit. In February 2002, we issued a report that summarized the results of these audits and the types of violations (none, minor, significant, and major) noted for each contractor. Twelve of the contractors listed had contract/labor law violations described as major or significant.

Results of Follow-up

Of the 12 contractors identified in our prior report having major or significant contract/labor law violations, five firms no longer have contracts with the County and one firm has a temporary month-to-month contract until the current solicitation process is completed and the department selects a replacement. Of the remaining six contractors, five have corrected the areas of non-compliance. The Department of Health Services is working with the remaining contractor to develop a corrective action plan to

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address the areas of non-compliance identified in our report and to address additional issues that came to the Department's attention after the completion of our review.

The following Chart lists the 12 contractors that we reviewed, the dates of our original reports, and the current status of the actions taken to address the contractors' contract/labor law violations.
