Subject: **COUNTY DEPARTMENTS' REVOLVING FUNDS AND REVOLVING  
CASH TRUST FUNDS AS OF JUNE 30, 2013**

Attached are detailed reports on County departments' Revolving Fund (Attachment I) and Revolving Cash Trust Fund (Attachment II) assignments. The reports show the responsible County officer, fund number, account number, and amount for each assignment as of June 30, 2013. The Auditor-Controller (A-C) is required to file this report with your Board annually.

**Background**

On April 4, 1978, your Board adopted a resolution, pursuant to Government Code Section 29321.1, authorizing the A-C to perform the functions of your Board to establish, discontinue, increase or decrease revolving funds. Departments use revolving funds to make change, small purchases, and for other specific purposes such as Cash Aid disbursements.

Similarly, on October 21, 1980, your Board adopted a resolution, pursuant to Government Code Section 25252.6, authorizing the A-C to perform the functions of your Board to establish and determine the amount of Revolving Cash Trust Funds (RCTF). Departments use RCTFs to expedite high volume refunds.

### **Summary of Activity**

Total Revolving Fund assignments as of June 30, 2013 were \$10,746,490. The Children and Families First Proposition 10 Commission (Commission) accounted for \$8 million of the total Revolving Fund assignments. The Commission is required to keep its funds in the County Treasury. The remaining \$2,746,490 in Revolving Funds are assigned to various County departments as detailed in Attachment I. Total RCTF assignments as of June 30, 2013 were \$325,500 as detailed in Attachment II.

For Fiscal Year 2012-13, Revolving Fund assignments decreased by a net of \$62,551, due to the following:

- The Department of Animal Care & Control decreased its Revolving Fund by \$5,000.
- The Department of Community & Senior Services decreased its Revolving Fund by \$7,200.
- The Office of County Counsel decreased its Revolving Fund by \$35,000.
- The Chief Executive Office closed its Revolving Fund totaling \$3,500.
- The Department of Health Services – Olive View Cash Aid increased its Revolving Fund by \$124.
- The Internal Services Department decreased its Revolving Fund by \$11,200.
- The Department of Parks and Recreation closed one of its Revolving Funds totaling \$750.
- The Probation Department closed one of its Revolving Funds totaling \$25.

RCTF assignments decreased by \$230,220, because the Department of Health Services – King/Drew Medical Center closed its RCTF totaling \$5,000; the Probation Department closed one of its RCTFs totaling \$220; and the Los Angeles Superior Court closed 6 of its RCTFs totaling \$225,000.

### Revolving Fund Assignments

Revolving fund monies, established in accordance with Government Code Section 29321.1, are available for use by department heads to make change when necessary in carrying out official County business, and to make authorized purchases of services and materials which are legal charges against the County. A departmental revolving fund can be assigned or sub-assigned to various locations (sections, divisions, etc.) within a department. Departments handle each sub-assignment in the same manner as the regular fund assignment.

Departments may also request revolving funds for specific purposes such as Cash Aid disbursements and grants. Regardless of the purpose, authority to spend funds must be granted in the Board approved budgetary process, and operating funds must be encumbered prior to making expenditures.

**Revolving Cash Trust Fund Assignments**

Revolving Cash Trust Funds (RCTF) are established in accordance with Section 25252.6 of the Government Code. An RCTF is an amount of cash requisitioned from trust and set aside to expedite high volume refunds. An RCTF can only be used by an officer or department head for payments which are legally payable out of the deposits in the trust fund from which the cash is being requisitioned.
