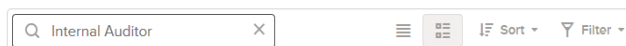
You may apply and participate in this recruitment if you anticipate that you will complete the following requirements by June 30, 2019

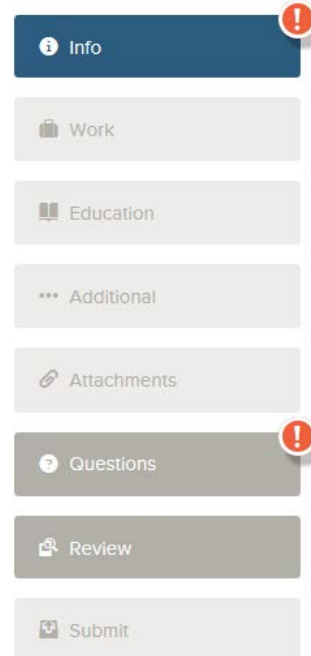
