## GROW UPDATE MAY 2002

### JOB PLACEMENTS

Since implementation in 2/99, a total of 28,419 participants have become employed through the GROW program.

- Metro East GROW held employer recruitment days on 5/21, 5/22 and 5/30. Employers included First Transit and Target, and over 25 participants attended these recruitment events.
- Pasadena GROW held recruitment days on 5/14 and 5/28 with GHG Security and the Los Angeles Housing Authority. Fourteen participants attended these recruitment events.
- On 5/8, 5/13, 5/17, 5/21, 5/22 and 5/29, San Fernando GROW held recruitment activities with Adecco, Goodwill Industries, Interviewing Services of America, Kelly Products and Teletech. Over 70 participants attended these events and seven have been hired thus far.
- Metro Special GROW held employer recruitment activities on 5/1, 5/9, 5/16, 5/21, 5/22, 5/23, 5/29 and 5/30 with Culinary Staffing, Durham, Langer Security, Pep Boys, Pinkerton Security, St. Joseph Center and Source One Staffing. Over 80 participants attended these events and three have been hired thus far. Staff also participated in and co-sponsored a job fair with Los Angeles Trade Tech College. Employers at this job fair included Bank of America, Commercial Staffing, Environmental Staffing and Wells Fargo Bank.
- San Gabriel Valley GROW held on-site employer recruitments on 5/8, 5/16 and 5/30 with Interview Services of America, Target and Volt. There were over 60 participants at these events and, to date, five have been hired.
- During May, South Central GROW held job recruitment activities with Laidlaw and Target. Over 25 participants were interviewed for positions and one has been hired thus far. An onsite recruitment was also held on 5/22, with 32 participants interviewed and five hired thus far.
- Pomona GROW held employer recruitment activities on 5/10, 5/21 and 5/31. Employers included Foothill Transit, Infinity Staffing, Rely Staffing and Team One. There were 125 participants who attended these events and, to date, one has been hired.

### PROGRAM PARTICIPATION

• Through May 2002, the cumulative participation rates for both Orientation and Job Skills Preparation Class continue to exceed 50%.
