**SUBJECT:** ESCAPE AND SUBSEQUENT APPREHENSION

This is to advise your Board that on December 23, 2003 at approximately 7:00 p.m., minor Julio O. (DOB 11-5-87) escaped from Central Juvenile Hall (CJH); he was subsequently apprehended by probation staff on December 24, 2003 at 7:45 a.m. CJH Superintendent Reaver Bingham and Assistant Superintendent Daniel Aceves arrested Julio O. at the home of minor's friend, without resistance, and returned the minor to juvenile hall. The mother of the minor was cooperative and instrumental in providing information that led to the apprehension of the minor.

The minor had been detained for a violation of probation by the court on the day of the escape. Minor was on probation for 626.10(a) PC (possession of weapon on school grounds).

The preliminary investigation indicates that the minor escaped through an unlocked window while awaiting the intake process. The Department will immediately review the circumstances for the breach of security and take the necessary corrective action.
