MOTION TO SEND LETTERS URGING SUPPORT FOR H.R. 2429, LAX NOISE COMMUNITY ACCOUNTABILITY ACT (ITEM NO. 9, AGENDA OF JULY 31, 2001)

Item No. 9 on the July 31, 2001 Agenda is a motion by Supervisor Knabe recommending that the Board send five-signature letters supporting H.R. 2429 (Waters, D-CA), the LAX Noise Community Accountability Act, to President Bush, Senators Feinstein and Boxer, and the County's Congressional delegation.

On June 28, 2001, Representative Maxine Waters introduced H.R. 2429, which would require the operator of the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), which is the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA), to prepare and mail an annual noise mitigation report to each household located in the 10-mile radius of the airport and any additional area covered under a noise compatibility program for the airport. The bill also would provide for the imposition of fines on LAWA if it fails to comply with the new reporting requirements.

There are no Board policies relating to the bill's provisions, and a position on the bill is a matter for Board policy determination. No hearing has been scheduled for the bill, which was referred to the House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee.
