ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

An ordinance amending Title 5 - Personnel, Chapter 5.12 -Tenure, Resignations and Vacancies, of the Los Angeles County Code by adding section 5.12.110, Disqualification from county employment.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 5.12.110 of Chapter 5.12 is hereby added to read as follows:

**5.12.110 Disqualification from county employment.**

Any applicant for county employment who has been convicted of workers' compensation fraud is barred from employment with the County of Los Angeles.
