Other agencies invited to participate in this City program are the Los Angeles County Department of Community and Senior Citizens Services, Sheriff, Mental Health, the City of Los Angeles Fire Department, and PacifiCare Health Systems.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The District serves 57 cities located throughout Los Angeles County. Approving the attached letter agreement would allow the District to continue to fulfill its mission of saving lives. It is consistent with the overall County Strategic Plan Goal #1.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

There will be no fiscal impact to the District. The City of Los Angeles and PacifiCare will absorb all costs of printing the materials and providing the packets.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Once the District has received Board approval, it will give permission to the City of Los Angeles to use the District name and logo only on information packets provided to seniors for the File of L.I.F.E. Program. The packets will be made available to seniors at all District fire stations and carried on the engine, truck, and squads. The District's Office of Public Information will keep a supply of the packets so that the fire stations can replenish their supplies.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

Approval of this letter agreement will not impact the District's current services or projects. It will enhance the services it now provides to the community.
