

SUBJECT: **ADJUSTMENT TO DONATION OF APRIL 5, 2005 FOR
OBREGON PARK BALLFIELD IMPROVEMENTS**

On April 5, 2005, the Board accepted, with thanks, a donation of ballfield improvements valued at \$63,000 from Bench Production, LLC to renovate an existing ball field at Eugene Obregon Park in East Los Angeles. The intent was to make the field in to a "dream field" to be used to film baseball scenes in a park setting.

Once filming began at other locations, the film's director made adjustments to the script and determined he wanted to use a stadium setting rather than the scenes proposed at Obregon in a park setting.

In a magnanimous gesture of graceful withdrawal, the production company is still going to provide many of the previously planned improvements. It will be giving the park a new electronic scoreboard, providing the baseball league with new uniforms and donating funds to the tiny tots and afterschool programs. They are also leaving it to us to select another major improvement such as the announcer's booth, new dugouts, etc. for the ball field.

The production company's location manager has highly complimented those within the County who worked with his company as extremely competent, accommodating and professional.

So, even though there may be some disappointment within the community that there will not be the excitement connected with the actual filming, this certainly is a winning situation for the community using Obregon Park.
