LOS ANGELES COUNTY WATERWORKS DISTRICT NO. 29, MALIBU EMERGENCY RELOCATION OF 12-INCH-DIAMETER WATER MAIN ON TOPANGA CANYON BOULEVARD

As a result of the February 3, 2005, rainstorm, a landslide occurred at Topanga Canyon Boulevard approximately 3.5 miles north of Pacific Coast Highway. W. A. Rasic Construction Company was called to assist District staff to temporarily relocate approximately 350 feet of 12-inch-diameter water main to above ground until Caltrans completes the repair of the roadway. The work was completed on April 10, 2005, at an estimated cost of \$90,000.

W. A. Rasic Construction Company is one of five as-needed, on-call emergency contractors, with a contract approved by your Board on December 1, 2003. We committed to reporting to your Board all emergency repairs carried out under these contracts.
