SUBJECT: **BUSINESS LICENSE ENFORCEMENT SUMMARY REPORT  
FOR THE QUARTER ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2005**

At the meeting of September 30, 1997, your Board approved amendments to the Los Angeles County Code requiring the Treasurer and Tax Collector, in cooperation with the Sheriff and the Department of Health Services, to implement a reporting format to track business license enforcement activity and to provide a quarterly summary to the Board of all license enforcement activities performed by the appropriate agencies.

**Sheriff's Town Hall Meeting, Unincorporated Community of East Rancho Dominguez, Second District**

The Sheriff's Department hosted a Town Hall meeting in the unincorporated community of East Rancho Dominguez on July 27, 2005. In addition to TTC, a number of County departments attended, such as Public Works, Regional Planning, and the Department of Health Services – Office of Environmental Health. During the meeting, TTC staff spoke with a number of residents regarding businesses operating in the community.

**Residential Facility Inspection - 5021 Angelus Vista Blvd., View Park, Second District**

On August 4, 2005, TTC staff participated in a multi-agency effort in response to complaints from residents of an unlicensed residential treatment facility at 5021 Angelus Vista Blvd., View Park. Agencies involved included the State of California-Community Care Licensing, the Sheriff, Community and Senior Services-Adult Protective Services, Public Works-Building and Safety, Mental Health, Regional Planning and TTC. The inspection of the property revealed seven to ten individuals living on site. Several of these individuals were determined to need constant care and supervision. The property owner was cited by the State for operating a residential care facility without a license. Regional Planning also issued a violation notice for operating a boarding house for more than four people (non-permitted use). Mental Health and Adult Protective Services staff assisted in placing those needing constant care and supervision at a licensed facility.

**Lennox Peddler Enforcement - Second District**

On August 5, 2005, TTC staff participated in a County multi-agency effort to enforce the County's Health and Business License Codes related to street peddling. The County agencies included the Sheriff, Health, Regional Planning, Public Works, and TTC. One catering truck was issued a warning notice for operating without a business license and was required to leave the location.

**Business License Denial - Live Entertainment, El Centenario Bar, 10720 Inglewood Ave., Lennox, Second District.**

On August 24, 2005, the Business License Commission conducted a public hearing prior to the granting of a Live Entertainment Business License for El Centenario, at 10720 Inglewood Ave., Lennox. At the public hearing a representative of the Sheriff's Lennox Station requested the license be denied. During the hearing the Sheriff's representative stated they conducted a bar compliance operation with TTC staff at this location on August 12, 2005. During this operation four patrons were arrested, three for possession of a controlled substance and one for public drunkenness. After the close of the public hearing the Business License Commission approved the recommendation to deny.
