APPROVAL OF DELEGATION OF DUTIES AND ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS TO PROVIDENCE HEALTH SYSTEM -SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

(All Districts) (3 Votes)

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

- Approve and instruct the Director of Health Services, or his designee, to sign Amendment No. 4 to County Agreement No. H-300135 and Amendment No. 1 to County Agreement No. H-207649 with Providence Health System-Southern California, d.b.a. Little Company of Mary Hospital for Hospital Bioterrorism Preparedness services and Paramedic Base Hospital services, substantially similar to Exhibits I and II, respectively, to assign and delegate all rights and responsibilities to Providence Health System-Southern California effective November 1, 2005.
- 2. Approve and instruct the Director of Health Services, or his designee, to sign Amendment No. 4 to County Agreement No. H-300164 with Providence Health Systems-Southern California, d.b.a. Little Company of Mary-San Pedro Hospital for Hospital Bioterrorism Preparedness services, substantially similar to Exhibit III, to assign and delegate all rights and responsibilities to Providence Health System-Southern California effective November 1, 2005.

PURPOSE OF THE RECOMMENDED ACTIONS/JUSTIFICATION:

Board approval of the recommended actions will authorize the assignment and delegation of the rights and responsibilities of Little Company of Mary Hospital and San Pedro Peninsula Hospital d.b.a. Little Company of Mary-San Pedro Hospital to Providence Health System-Southern California for the continued provision of Bioterrorism Preparedness and Paramedic Base Hospital services.

The Bioterrorism Preparedness service agreements provide for the development, implementation, and evaluation of a hospital terrorism preparedness program at each participating hospital and the Paramedic Base Hospital services agreement

provides for verbal medical instructions to paramedics in the field over a radio or commercial telephone by a physician and mobile intensive care nurses at the designated base hospital.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no net County cost associated with these actions.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS:

On June 18, 2002, the Board approved a Paramedic Base Hospital Agreement with designated base hospitals for the continued provision of emergency care. Little Company of Mary is one of the designated base hospitals. The agreement with Little Company of Mary became effective on July 1, 2002 with provisions for yearly renewals through June 30, 2007.

On January 21, 2003, the Board approved the first Hospital Bioterrorism Preparedness Expanded Agreements through March 31, 2004 with Little Company of Mary (County Agreement No. H-300135) and San Pedro Peninsula Hospital d.b.a. Little Company of Mary-San Pedro Hospital (H-300164) with funding provided through a grant award from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA).

On January 18, 2005, the Board approved acceptance of a Notice of Grant Award (Year 3) from HRSA and delegated authority to the Director of Health Services to accept future Notices of Grant Awards retroactive to August 31, 2004 and to select providers, negotiate, and execute agreements through March 30, 2007.

On November 1, 2005, Little Company of Mary Hospital, a California non-profit corporation and San Pedro Peninsula Hospital d.b.a. Little Company of Mary-San Pedro Hospital, merged with Providence Health System-Southern California, a non-profit religious corporation.

Approval of the recommended actions will allow for hospital bioterrorism preparedness and emergency medical care through base hospital services to continue without interruption.
