**NOTIFICATION OF CONTRACT CITIES
INCREASE OF SERVICE LEVELS**

On March 1, 2005, your Board requested that the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (Department) provide notification to the Board of Supervisors regarding increases to existing contracts.

The purpose of this letter is to advise the Board of Supervisors that our Department received written notice on August 3, 2006, that the Cities of Agoura Hills, Calabasas, Hidden Hills, Malibu, and Westlake Village collectively increased their Contract Law Enforcement Services effective August 6, 2006. They added the time equivalent of one Law Enforcement Technician (LET). The LET is being used to collect latent fingerprints and is assigned to the Crime Lab.

The City of Commerce increased their Contract City Law Enforcement Services effective May 1, 2007. They added the equivalent of one deputy who will be deployed in the City of Commerce. This increase will be staffed by utilizing existing deputy personnel to fill the position via overtime. This contract increase will not have an impact on the level of service being provided in the unincorporated areas.

The City of Lancaster increased their Contract City Law Enforcement Services effective April 1, 2007. They added the equivalent of ten patrol deputies. This increase will be staffed by utilizing existing deputy personnel to work overtime to fill the position. This contract increase will not have an impact on the level of service being provided in the unincorporated areas.

The Lancaster Eastside School District increased their Contract City Law Enforcement Services effective February 1, 2007. They added the equivalent of one patrol deputy. This increase will be staffed by utilizing existing deputy personnel to work overtime to fill the position. This contract increase will not have an impact on the level of service being provided in the unincorporated areas.

The City of Paramount increased their Contract City Law Enforcement Services effective February 1, 2007. They added the equivalent of one patrol sergeant. This increase will be staffed by utilizing existing sergeant personnel to work overtime to fill the position. This contract increase will not have an impact on the level of service being provided in the unincorporated areas.

The City of Rosemead changed their Contract City Law Enforcement Services, effective May 1, 2007. They deleted one deputy from the city and added one sergeant position to be deployed in the City of Rosemead. This contract increase will not have an impact on the level of service being provided in the unincorporated areas.
