**ACCEPT A DONATION OF \$80,000 FROM THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD TO

(THIRD DISTRICT) (3 VOTES)**

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

1. Accept from the City of West Hollywood a donation of \$80,000 for the remodel, construction material, equipment, and furniture for the West Hollywood Sheriff's Station dispatch center.
2. Upon your Board's approval, instruct the Executive Officer of the Board to send a letter of appreciation to the City of West Hollywood, 8300 Santa Monica Boulevard, West Hollywood, California 90069, for their generous donation.

PURPOSE OF RECOMMENDED ACTION/JUSTIFICATION

The donated money from the City of West Hollywood will be utilized to remodel and purchase furniture, construction material, and equipment for the West Hollywood Sheriff's Station dispatch center.

Acceptance of this donation promotes Strategic Plan Goal 1, Service Excellence, as this donation will further demonstrate the value of a public/private partnership that improves County services to the citizens of Los Angeles County.
