**EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE BOARD MANAGEMENT APPOINTMENT**

Consistent with the August 4, 1998 Board-approved policy on managerial salaries, we have reviewed and recommend Board approval of the Executive Office of the Board's request to appoint Mr. John Wei to the position of Departmental Chief Information Officer I with a salary of \$10,838 monthly and/or \$130,056 annually. The requested salary will place Mr. Wei in MAPP Tier I, third quartile of R13 salary structure and will provide him a 10 percent increase over his current base salary of \$9,853 monthly and/or \$118,236 annually.

Mr. Wei obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration, Management Information Systems in 1996, and has continued his education by participating in multiple classes relative to software, hardware, telecommunications and facility infrastructure. In addition, he currently manages an Information Resource Management Division and has over 20 years of progressively responsible information technology experience.

If appointed to the Departmental Chief Information Officer I, Mr. Wei will report to the Executive Officer, Board of Supervisors and will be responsible for managing complex and unique information technology requirements specific to each Board office which necessitates high-level security measures to ensure confidentiality within the Department and between Board offices. The position will also ensure these secure state-of-the-art information technology services are available to Board members and their staff at all times.
