SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR 2017-18 CASH FLOW PROJECTION

Attached is the latest cash flow projection for the General Fund and Hospital Funds. The estimated June 30, 2017 combined cash balances for the General Fund and Hospital Funds are positive \$1.271 billion. This amount remains unchanged from the previous month's estimate.

Short-Term Outlook

Our previous report estimated the October 31, 2017 cash balances at positive \$1.077 billion. The actual cash balances were positive \$1.601 billion and included \$800 million of unspent Tax and Revenue Anticipation Note proceeds. The variance of \$524 million was largely due to higher than anticipated health services cash receipts primarily from the Managed Care Rate Supplements and Medicaid Coverage Expansion programs. The estimated November 30, 2017 combined cash balances are positive \$851 million.
