**ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FOR A  
LIFELONG LEARNING CENTER AT PICO RIVERA LIBRARY  
(SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 1) (3 VOTES)**

**SUBJECT**

The Public Library is recommending Board acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$229,912 from the Institute of Museum and Library Services to fund a Lifelong Learning Center at the Pico Rivera Library. This grant is a congressionally directed award through the office of Grace Napolitano, 38<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. The grant award will end on June 30, 2010.

**IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:**

1. Accept a grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services, which is a congressionally directed award, in the amount of \$229,912 to fund a Lifelong Learning Center at the Pico Rivera Library. The grant funds will be used to purchase computers, furniture, library materials and other necessary services and supplies to implement the grant project.
2. Authorize the County Librarian to act on the County's behalf regarding the execution and completion of all documents relating to the project as may be required under the conditions of the grant program, to expend the funds as necessary for the completion of the project, and to meet the conditions of the grant.

### **PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION**

The Public Library is recommending Board acceptance of a grant award in the amount of \$229,912 from the Institute of Museum and Library Services' appropriation for reading and other educational programs for 2008. This grant is a congressionally directed award through the office of Grace Napolitano, 38<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. Approval of the recommended action will allow the Public Library to fund a Lifelong Learning Center at the Pico Rivera Library. The Lifelong Learning Center will meet the growing demand in the community for computer access, teen services, parent/child activities and English language learning materials.

### **Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals**

Approval of the recommended actions is consistent with the County's Strategic Plan Goals in the areas of Service Excellence (1), Fiscal Responsibility (4), and Children and Families' Well-Being (5).

### **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING**

The Lifelong Learning Center grant in the amount of \$229,912 is in federal funds administered by the Institute of Museum and Library Services. This grant, which will be received by the Public Library on a reimbursement basis, will end on June 30, 2010. The grant funds will be used to purchase computers, furniture, library materials, and other necessary services and supplies to implement the grant project. The Public Library's operating budget has the appropriation to cover expenditures from this grant. Acceptance of this grant award does not require matching funds from the Public Library and does not commit the County to provide ongoing services.

### **FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS**

Congresswoman Grace Napolitano, 38th Congressional District, directed an appropriation in the amount of \$229,912 for the Pico Rivera Library in 2008. The Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) is the federal agency designated to administer these federal funds. On July 15, 2008, the Public Library submitted an application to IMLS for this non-competitive grant for the implementation of a Lifelong Learning Center at the Pico Rivera Library. The grant was awarded to the Public Library on August 29, 2008.

County policy requires that grants be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for acceptance. A Grant Management Statement, which is required when the grant amount is \$100,000 or more, is attached (Attachment A).

**IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES**

This grant will enable the Public Library to enhance its services and programs at the Pico Rivera Library by providing resources that support the lifelong learning of the residents in the City of Pico Rivera.
