RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS FOR A GRANT FOR THE MARINA DEL REY PUBLIC BOAT LAUNCH FACILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 4) (3 VOTES)

SUBJECT

This action is to approve a resolution in support of a grant application to the State Department of Boating and Waterways for the Department of Beaches and Harbors' Marina del Rey Public Boat Launch Facility Improvement Project and to accept the grant funding if awarded.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

- 1. Find that Marina del Rey Public Boat Launch Facility Improvement Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Classes 2(a) and 3(b) of the County's Environmental Document Reporting Procedures and Guidelines.
- 2. Adopt a Resolution approving the Department of Beaches and Harbors' submittal to the State Department of Boating and Waterways of a grant application in the amount of \$4,600,000 for the Marina del Rey Public Boat Launch Facility Improvement Project.
- 3. Authorize the acceptance of grant funding of up to \$4,600,000 from the State Department of Boating and Waterways for the Marina del Rey Public Boat Launch Facility Improvement Project if awarded.

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4. Authorize the Director of the Department of Beaches and Harbors, or his designee, to sign all necessary documents to obtain and accept the grant for the purpose of funding the Marina del Rey Public Boat Launch Facility Improvement Project and to act as lead agent for the County when conducting business with the State Department of Boating and Waterways on any and all matters related to the grant.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approval of the recommendations will enable the Department of Beaches and Harbors (Department) to apply for and accept a grant from the State of California Department of Boating and Waterways (DBAW) to fully fund the refurbishment of the Marina del Rey public boat launch facility.

The public boat launch facility at Marina del Rey is in need of refurbishment to enhance components to serve modern and larger watercraft and to keep it maintained in a safe and satisfactory condition. DBAW provides grant funding for these purposes to publically owned marinas.

The grant funds will be used to: (1) replace the boarding floats and guide piles; (2) add a staging dock with guide piles; (3) add an 80-foot Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible gangway; (4) widen the entrance driveway; (5) repave and mark the parking lot and the access way; and (6) replace the chain link fence, improve the drainage and make additional miscellaneous improvements.

DBAW reserves the right to fund improvements as money becomes available in its budget. Therefore, DBAW may fund all, some or no improvements in any given fiscal year. For this reason, the main project will be phased as funding becomes available and the improvements will be itemized with a five-year cost escalation. Each improvement item will be brought to your Board for approval as a project in the fiscal year in which DBAW is prepared to provide funding.

The attached resolution (Attachment I) must accompany the Department's grant application submittal to DBAW, due on April 1, 2009.

No local match is required for the grant if awarded. However, if awarded, DBAW requires that all the projects constructed or refurbished with State money provided by DBAW be maintained for at least 20 years by the local jurisdictions at no additional cost to the State.

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Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

Actively seeking grant funding to refurbish public facilities and reduce the County's costs is consistent with the County's Strategic Plan Goals of Service Excellence (Goal 1) and Fiscal Responsibility (Goal 4).

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The project cost for the Marina del Rey Public Boat Launch Facility Improvement Project will be determined upon the receipt of bids. However, it is expected that the grant amount of \$4,600,000 will fully pay for the project with no increase in net County cost.

Operating Budget Impact

There will be no impact on the Department's operating budget.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Your Board's approval is required to allow the Director of the Department to sign both the grant application and agreement with DBAW and receive the grant funding for the project.

On July 11, 2000, your Board approved a requirement that County departments prepare a Grant Management Statement for your review when recommending grants of \$100,000 or more. Accordingly, the Grant Management Statement for this grant is attached for your Board's review (Attachment II).

All documents required for the acceptance of the requested grant will be subject to prior approval as to form by County Counsel.

ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Classes 2(a) and 3(b) of the County's Environmental Document Reporting Procedures and Guidelines adopted by your Board on November 17, 1987, as it consists of replacement of existing facilities and the addition of an appurtenant structure.

CONTRACTING PROCESS

The Department of Public Works will bring each improvement project phase back to your Board for approval as a project when DBAW is ready to provide the funding.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

The acceptance of the grant funds will have no negative effect on the Department's current projects.
