LOS ANGELES COUNTY WATERWORKS DISTRICT NO. 29, MALIBU EMERGENCY REPAIR OF 30-INCH, HIGH PRESSURE TRANSMISSION WATER MAIN

On August 29, 2002, the 30-inch-diameter, high pressure transmission water main at 19562 Pacific Coast Highway leaked. A. A. Portanova was called to assist District staff to repair the leak. The work was completed on August 30, 2002, at an estimated cost of \$40,000.

On December 1, 1998, your Board approved agreements with three contractors for emergency water distribution system repair services for the Waterworks Districts. As authorized by Section 22050 of the Public Contract Code, your Board delegated to us the authority to conduct emergency repairs or replacements of public facilities without the need for public competitive bidding.

Section 22050 also requires us to report to your Board all actual emergency repair or replacement work performed under the contract agreements.
