This Amendment Number Two (hereinafter referred to as "Amendment") to the Urine Sample Collection for Drug and Alcohol Testing Services Contract Number 76862, (hereinafter referred to as "Contract") is made and entered into at Los Angeles, California this 1st day of November, 2010, by and between County of Los Angeles (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY") and Pacific Toxicology Laboratories (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR").

WHEREAS, this Amendment Number two to the Contract is prepared and executed by COUNTY and CONTRACTOR as set forth in the Contract, Part II, STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS, SECTION 7.0, CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are parties to the Contract Number 76862, adopted by the Board on December 9, 2008, and CONTRACTOR has been providing Urine Sample Collection for Drug and Alcohol Testing Services to the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Amendment Number Two is to exercise the second renewal option to extend the term of this Contract for one additional year, effective January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011; and

NOW THEREFORE, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR mutually agree to the following changes to the Contract:

1. Part I, UNIQUE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, SECTION 2.0, **TERM** is amended to add subparagraph 2.1.2 as follows:
 - 2.1.2 The second renewal option is exercised extending the term of this contract for one additional year, effective January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011.


