## A SPECIAL REPORT FROM LOS ANGELES COUNTY FIRE CHIEF DARYL L. OSBY

### TYPE OF INCIDENT:

Mutual Aid Assistance to Kern County

### DATE AND TIME OF OCCURRENCE:

July 8, 2012, at 3:41 p.m.

### INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Lancer Incident: On Sunday, July 8, at 3:21 p.m., a brush fire was reported near Lebec Oaks Road, Lancer Way and Star Court in the City of Lebec in Kern County. Due to the moderate rate of spread, Kern County officials requested Los Angeles County Fire mutual aid assistance at 3:41 p.m. At 6:20 p.m., Kern County Fire reported the fire was 80% contained and holding at 50 acres. Approximately 120 Kern County fire personnel, assisted by LACoFD and United States Forest Service firefighters, are battling the blaze, along with three helicopters and three fixed-winger air tankers. LACoFD resources assigned to this incident include one strike team consisting of two camp crews who remain on scene. There is currently no fire involvement in Los Angeles County.
