SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF THE USE OF DELEGATED AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT THREE NOTICES OF GRANT AWARD FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, HEALTH RESOURCES AND SERVICES ADMINISTRATION FOR THE HIV EMERGENCY RELIEF PROJECT

This is to notify you that I am exercising the delegated authority approved by your Board on June 1, 2010, to accept future Notices of Grant Award (NGAs) substantially similar to NGA Number 2 H89HA000-16-20-00, from the Health Resources and Services Administration, that provide the Ryan White Program (RWP) and Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI) funding through February 28, 2014, subject to review and approval by County Counsel and the Chief Executive Office (CEO), and notification to your Board.

On March 27, 2012, I notified your Board that I was exercising the delegated authority referenced above to accept NGA Number 2 H89HA00016-22-00 in the amount of \$40,851,564, for the budget period of March 1, 2012 through February 28, 2013 for the HIV Emergency Relief Project, for RWP Year 22, comprised of federal Part A formula funds in the amount of \$26,338,159; Supplemental funds in the amount of \$11,226,557; and MAI funds in the amount of \$3,286,848.

Under the same authority, I will accept:

- 1) NGA Number 6 H89HA00016-22-01, issued March 14, 2012, to remove a Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act requirement in which recipients must report information for each subaward of \$25,000 or more in federal and executive total compensation. This requirement does not apply to grants issued prior to October 2010;

- 2) NGA Number 6 H89HA00016-19-0, issued November 19, 2012, to de-obligate \$10,814.91 in unspent funds from budget period March 1, 2009 through February 28, 2010; and
- 3) NGA Number 6 H89HA00016-22-02, issued November 27, 2012, to carryover unspent MAI funds in the amount of \$822,455 from the budget period of March 1, 2011 to February 29, 2012 to the current budget period of March 1, 2012 through February 28, 2013, increasing the total financial assistance for the current term from \$40,851,564 to \$41,674,019.

The RWP and MAI funding supports a range of vital healthcare and ancillary services including medical outpatient, oral health care, substance abuse treatment, medical and non-medical case management, mental healthcare, and early intervention services that serve as a safety net for low income and uninsured/underinsured Los Angeles County residents with HIV/AIDS. Notification of the acceptance of these NGAs was delayed due to administrative staff oversight and competing priorities within the Department of Public Health's (DPH) Division of HIV and STD Programs.

DPH will request approval of an appropriation adjustment, as needed.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the NGAs as to form. County Counsel and the CEO have reviewed and approved this delegated authority action.
