SUBJECT: **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS/AMENDMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 26 Amendments to existing and/or new Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreements, Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), Clinical Assessment programs and execution of 13 new Agreements processed in the month of December 2012 as follows:

1. **Amendment No. 6A (MH9019) with The Regents of the University of California** updates the Additional Group Providers Listing.
2. **Agreement (MH9036) with Das Care, Inc.**, is being executed under the Fee-For-Service Agreement from August 23, 2012, through June 30, 2014.
3. **Amendment No. 2 (MH29404) with Gadson Johnson, M.D.**, changes legal name from Gadson J. Johnson, M.D., A Medical Corporation, to Gadson Johnson, M.D.
4. **Agreement (MH010093) with Biola University, Inc.**, renews Affiliation Agreement from December 14, 2012, through June 30, 2017.
5. **Amendment No. 5 (MH050039) with California Institute for Mental Health** defunds Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Co-Occurring Joint Action Council (COJAC) funding in the amount of \$20,000. State Department of Mental Health will no longer approve funding for SAMHSA COJAC that do not provide direct services. The Total Compensation Amount (TCA) will be \$514,875.
6. **Amendment No. 5 (MH120853) with Exodus Recovery, Inc.**, decreases Innovation Programs Medi-Cal/Healthy Families (HF) Funded Program funds in the amount of \$288,795 and increases Innovation Programs Non Medi-Cal/Non

HF in the amount of \$144,397. The revised Maximum Contract Amount (MCA) will be \$16,621,834.

7. **Amendment No. 3 (MH120867) with Kedren Community Health Center, Inc.**, increases Psychiatric Emergency Services (PES) Relief Plan Non Medi-Cal/Non HF in the amount of \$1,222,852. The revised MCA will be \$34,833,545.
8. **Amendment No. 5 (MH120922) with PROTOTYPES, Centers for Innovation in Health, Mental Health, and Social Services** increases Post-Release Community Supervision (PCS)-Community Reintegration Program (CRP) Non Medi-Cal/ Non HF in the amount of \$381,362. The revised MCA will be \$7,661,605.
9. **Amendment No. 3 (MH120959) with St. Joseph Center** shifts Innovations Integrated Mobile Health Team (IMHT) funds from Non Medi-Cal Manual Invoices to Non Medi-Cal Direct Services in the amount of \$39,714, and Innovations Integrated Service Management Model (ISM) funds from Non Medi-Cal Direct Services to Non Medi-Cal Manual Invoices in the amount of \$111,625. There is no change in the MCA.
10. **Amendment No. 6 (MH120965) with Telecare Corporation** changes name of Telecare Corporation, Provider Number (PN) 7844, located at 1005 S. Central Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90021, to Telecare Los Angeles AB 109. There is no change in the MCA.
11. **Agreement (MH120968) with Eggleston Youth Centers, Inc.**, is being executed under the Legal Entity Agreement. The term of the Agreement is December 11, 2012, through June 30, 2015.
12. **Amendment No. 3 (MH150263) with Mission Road Pharmacy, Inc., dba Mission Road Pharmacy** assigns stock purchase to Mission Road Pharmacy effective November 30, 2012.
13. **Amendment No. 5 (MH190076) with Mental Health Advocacy Services, Inc.**, extends the term of the Agreement for six months from January 1, 2013, through June 30, 2013.
14. **Agreement (MH190104) with 1736 Family Crisis Center** is being executed under the Enhanced Emergency Shelter Program for Transition Age Youth Agreement. The term of the Agreement is December 6, 2012, through June 30, 2017.

The following two Administrative Amendments (15 and 16) to LE Agreements modify the Financial Summary Subprogram Schedule with no change to the MCA:

- 15. Amendment No. 2A (MH120840) with Braswell Rehabilitation Institute for Development of Growth and Education Services, Inc.**
- 16. Amendment No. 9A (MH120912) with Hillview Mental Health Center, Inc.**

The following two Agreements (17 and 18) are being executed under the Settlement Agreement for repayment:

- 17. Agreement (MH190106) with LAMP, Inc., cash flow debt of \$183,746.88 over a period of six months.**
- 18. Agreement (MH190107) with The Children's Center of the Antelope Valley repayment of \$61,569.45.**

The following two Amendments (19 and 20) to LE and Specialized Agreements add, delete, and/or move delivery sites. There is no change to the MCA:

- 19. Amendment No. 1 (MH120837) with ASC Treatment Group dba The Anne Sippi Clinic moves its Service Delivery Site Medi-Cal/Short-Doyle PN 7589 from 10012 Norwalk Blvd., Suite No. 110, Santa Fe Springs, CA 90670, to 2057 S. Atlantic Blvd., Commerce, CA 90040. There is no change in the MCA.**
- 20. Amendment No. 1 (MH120967) with University Muslim Medical Association, Inc., adds a new service delivery site at 5849 Cocker Street, Unit K, Los Angeles, CA 90011, under PN To Be Determined (TBD), adds Mode 45, Service Function Codes (SFCs) 10-19, Mental Health Promotion, SFCs 20-29, CCS, deletes PN 7839 located at 711 West Florence Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90044. The MCA remains unchanged at \$692,280.**

The following two Agreements (21 and 22) are being executed under the Pharmacy Agreement:

- 21. Agreement (MH150296) with Modern Health Specialty (AD-RX), LLC, the term of the Agreement is December 10, 2012, through June 30, 2015.**
- 22. Agreement (MH150297) with Modern Health Holdings, Inc., dba Modern Health Pharmacy, the term of the Agreement is December 18, 2012, through June 30, 2015.**

The following two Amendments (23 and 24) to LE Agreements enable contractor to provide new or additional eligible Healthy Way L.A. services:

- 23. Amendment No. 1 (MH120865) with Institute for Multicultural Counseling & Services (I.M.C.E.S.)** increases Medi-Cal/Non HF in the amount of \$9,907. The revised MCA will be \$3,748,024.
- 24. Amendment No. 7 (MH120965) with Telecare Corporation** increases Non Medi-Cal/Non HF in the amount of \$176,058. The revised MCA will be \$12,890,402.

The following two Amendments (25 and 26) to LE and Specialized Agreements increase/decrease and/or add MHSA Full Service Partnership (FSP) and Field Capable Clinical Services (FCCS) for Non Medi-Cal/Non HF and Non Medi-Cal/HF funds:

- 25. Amendment No. 7 (MH120886) with Special Service of Groups** decreases MHSA FSP Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$303,405; decreases MHSA FSP Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$685,000; decreases MHSA FCCS Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$40,093; and decreases MHSA FCCS Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$110,133. The revised MCA will be \$34,803,724.
- 26. Amendment No. 3 (MH120928) with Tessie Cleveland Community Service Corporation** adds MHSA FSP Non Medi-Cal/HF in the amount of \$303,405; MHSA FSP Medi-Cal/HF in the amount of \$685,000; adds FCCS Non Medi-Cal/Non HF in the amount of \$40,093; and adds MHSA FCCS Medi-Cal/HF in the amount of \$110,133. The revised MCA will be \$10,154,088.

The following three Amendments (27 through 29) to LE Agreements add/increase and/or delete Service Function Code (SFC):

- 27. Amendment No. 2 (MH120832) with 1736 Family Crisis Center** deletes Mode 18, SFC 62, Medication Support Services from PN 7111 and PN 7348. Service Exhibit 3 is deleted from Agreement. There is no change in the MCA.
- 28. Amendment No. 2 (MH120843) with Child and Family Center** increases the MHSA Probation Camp Funded Program in the amount of \$100,000 and adds a new satellite service site under PN 7479 at Camp Munz/Mendenhall, 42220-42230 N. Lake Hughes Road, Lake Hughes, CA 93532-1012. Services to be provided at new satellite service site include Mode 15, SFCs 01-09, Targeted Case Management, Mode 15, SFCs 10-19/30-59, Mental Health

Services, and Mode 15, SFCs 70-79, Crisis Intervention, under PN 7479. The revised MCA will be \$9,735,361.

29. **Amendment No. 1 (MH120958) with St. Francis Medical Center** adds Mode 15, Outpatient Services, SFCs 77, Crisis Intervention to PN 7636 and PN 7637. There is no change in the MCA.

The following five Amendments (30 through 34) delegate the duties and assign the rights under the Agreement due to the merger of Sun Health Group, Inc., into a wholly owned subsidiary of Genesis HealthCare, LLC, on December 1, 2012. There is no change in the MCA:

34. **Amendment No. 3 (MH150263) with Mission Road Pharmacy, Inc., dba Mission Road Pharmacy** assigns all rights and responsibilities to Mission Road Pharmacy, Inc.

37. **Agreement (MH200381) with United Job Creation Council**, the term of the Agreement is December 3, 2012, through June 30, 2016.
38. **Agreement (MH200383) with Brookside Education, Inc.**, the term of the Agreement is December 17, 2012, through June 30, 2016.

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39. **Agreement (MH200384) with Paving the Way Foundation**, the term of the Agreement is December 12, 2012, through June 30, 2016.

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
