



# MAJOR INCIDENT REPORT

## A SPECIAL REPORT FROM LOS ANGELES COUNTY FIRE CHIEF DARYL L. OSBY

### TYPE OF INCIDENT:

Assistance to Ventura County Fire Department

### DATE AND TIME OF OCCURRENCE:

April 8, 2013, at 5:24 p.m.

### INCIDENT SUMMARY:

**Goodenough Incident:** On Monday, April 8, at 4:44 p.m., a structure fire occurred at 1437 Goodenough Road in the City of Fillmore in Ventura County. After the fire spread to nearby brush, Ventura County Fire officials requested Los Angeles County Fire's assistance at 5:24 p.m. for structure protection. This morning at 6 a.m., Ventura County Fire reported that the fire had burned 147 acres and was 80 percent contained. Approximately 400 firefighters, including LACoFD personnel, battled the blaze on the ground, aided by three helicopters. LACoFD resources assigned to this incident include four strike teams, including two camp crews, plus two battalion chiefs, two heli-tenders, and three copters. Three of the strike teams were released earlier this morning, and one remains on scene. Full containment of the fire is expected by 12 noon. There is currently no fire involvement in Los Angeles County.
