

SUBJECT: **NOTIFICATION OF THE USE OF DELEGATED AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH JARS OF CLAY TREATMENT CENTER II, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF DRUG/MEDI-CAL SERVICES**

This is to notify you that I am exercising the delegated authority approved by your Board on June 7, 2011, to offer and execute future alcohol and drug services agreements for the provision of Drug/Medi-Cal (DMC) program services to all eligible State-certified DMC agencies, effective upon agency DMC certification date or July 1 of the current fiscal year or upon the start date requested by the agency between these two time periods, upon the agency's submission and approval by the Department of Public Health of all required documents, allowing for State approved retroactive payments through June 30, 2014, subject to review and approval by County Counsel, and notification to your Board and the Chief Executive Office.

Pursuant to both State legislation and the federal ruling of Sobky v. Smoley, counties are required to enter into agreements with all State-certified DMC service providers who request service contracts and who demonstrate the ability to comply with all local requirements.

Under the delegated authority referenced above, I will execute a DMC agreement with Jars of Clay Treatment Center II, Inc., for the provision of Outpatient Drug Free Services, Day Care Habilitative Services, Perinatal Outpatient Drug Free Services, and Perinatal Day Care Habilitative Services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2014, at an annual obligation of \$100,000 and a total maximum obligation of \$200,000; 100 percent offset by State Realignment revenues as authorized under Assembly Bill 118 and federal Medicaid matching funds.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the agreement as to form and this delegated authority action.
