Dear Supervisors:

I am pleased to announce that Los Angeles County (County) has been selected as the large county pilot site for the California Department of Justice's Statewide Information Sharing System.

The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (Department) was notified in early 2012, that California Attorney General Kamala Harris directed the Department of Justice (DOJ) to pursue the development of a Statewide Information Sharing Solution (Sharing Solution), which will contain information on individuals assigned to Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS), as a result of Assembly Bill 109. DOJ invited the Department to formally participate in a pilot project to develop the solution, as over a third of the PRCS population resides in the County. During the past year, DOJ held stakeholder meetings in counties throughout the State, which served to strongly reinforce the need for DOJ to develop and host a Sharing Solution with PRCS individuals.

Subsequently, DOJ secured the money, developed the requirements and system standard, documents, and solicited a vendor through a Request for Offer process. Attorney General Harris is expected to announce the vendor in the next few weeks. DOJ will then immediately begin to work with staff from the County Probation and the Department to implement the Sharing Solution, which is expected to be in production by the end of 2013.

The Sharing Solution will ultimately contain information from all 58 county probation departments, the State Special Release Files, including all of those from the PRCS population, the Department of Motor Vehicles, and other disparate State systems. All State law enforcement agencies will have access to this system. The pilot project in the
