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

NOTIFICATION TO EXTEND THE INTER-UNIVERSITY CONSORTIUM TRAINING SERVICES CONTRACT

This is to notify the Board that I have used Board-delegated authority, as adopted by the Board on June 18, 2013, to extend the Inter-University Consortium (IUC) Training Services contracts with the six current contractors effective January 1, 2014, through June 30, 2014. The six contractors are: California State, Los Angeles University Auxilliary Services, Inc. (CSULA); California State University, Dominguez Hills Foundation (CSUDH); California State University, Long Beach Foundation (CSULB); The University Corporation [for California State University, Northridge] (CSUN), The Regents of the University of California (UCLA), and The University of Southern California (USC). Additionally, I have also used Board-delegated authority, as adopted by the Board on June 9, 2009, to increase UCLA's contract sum by \$240,000, representing an annual increase of 9.3% of the original Maximum Annual Contract Sum.

The six-month extension, which has been approved by the State, will ensure that training will continue to be provided to DCFS staff while a new contract with UCLA, which will serve as the prime contractor, is procured by negotiation. IUC Training services contractors provide training for Department staff and Master of Social Work Internship Program services. The additional six-month extension will allow DCFS to continue the provision of DCFS staff training and MSW Internship Program services while the new contract negotiation process continues.

The aggregate Maximum Contract Amount for these contracts is \$4,394,500, financed using 75 percent (\$3,295,875) Federal revenue, 17.5 percent (\$769,038) State funds, and 7.5 percent (\$329,587) net County cost. Funding is included in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-2014 CEO Recommended Budget.
