SUBJECT: **NOTIFICATION OF THE USE OF DELEGATED AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER 14-460-250 FROM THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD FOR A BEACH SAFETY PROGRAM FOR MONITORING WATER QUALITY**

This is to notify you that I am exercising the delegated authority approved by your Board on January 15, 2013, to accept grants from the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), at amounts determined by the SWRCB, for ocean water quality monitoring and public notification service for the period of July 1, 2012 through September 30, 2018, subject to review and approval by County Counsel, and notification to your Board and the Chief Executive Office.

Under this authority, I will accept Grant Agreement Number 14-460-250, issued by the SWRCB on December 31, 2014, in an amount not to exceed \$305,000, comprised of State funds totaling \$145,000 for the term of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015 and federal funds totaling \$160,000 for the term of October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015. These funds will allow the Department of Public Health Environmental Health's Recreational Waters Program to continue to monitor water quality at public beaches and provide all locational data, monitoring data, and notification data, in accordance with the SWRCB's requirements.

The Grant Agreement includes a requirement that the County maintain a self-insurance program. As the County is self-insured, the State has agreed to accept the County's Certificate of Self-Funding of Insurance Obligation for its liabilities. The Grant Agreement also requires the County to indemnify the State for all claims and losses relating to the Agreement. This is a standard requirement of the State and cannot be waived. I have been advised by Risk Management and County Counsel of the risks associated with this provision. However, I believe these risks to be acceptable in light of the need for the program funds and the resulting benefit to public health.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the grant agreement and this delegated authority action.
