REPORT BACK ON FUNDING OPTIONS TO PAY HALF OF ANNUAL OPERATING COSTS OF DONATED MOBILE SPAY/NEUTER VEHICLE (ITEM NO. 43-A, AGENDA OF SEPTEMBER 8, 2015)

On September 8, 2015, a motion by Supervisor Antonovich and Supervisor Solis instructed the Director of Animal Care and Control to work with the Interim Chief Executive Officer to identify funding options to pay for the remainder of annual operating costs for the new donated mobile spay/neuter vehicle. This vehicle will be donated by the Coalition of Pets and Public Safety.

Background

The Department of Animal Care and Control (DACC) has received a generous offer from the Coalition for Pets and Public Safety, a local nonprofit animal welfare organization, for the donation of a brand new mobile spay/neuter clinic and half a year of operating costs to run the clinic. The mobile clinic will allow DACC staff to provide spay/neuter services to various communities where the public may not have access to convenient transportation.
