On July 7, 2015, the Board instructed the Department of Health Services (DHS) to work with the leadership of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Hospital (MLK CH) to develop and report back to the Board, in writing, on a quarterly basis, a dashboard that assesses the new hospital's patient workload.

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The attached dashboard covers the April through June 2016 period and was developed together by DHS and the MLK CH. It draws from information obtained from both the MLK CH and MLK Outpatient Center (MLK OC). The dashboard continues to guide the collaborative efforts between the hospital and the outpatient center. We look forward to updating the dashboard quarterly and evolving its content over time, so that it is a valuable tool for collaborative planning between MLK CH and MLK OC.
