**AWARD OF CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT  
LOS ANGELES BASIN  
GROUNDWATER RECHARGE STUDY  
ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS  
3 VOTES**

**IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:**

Authorize the Director of Public Works to enter into an agreement with CH2MHill to identify, compile information, and create a search tool for favorable groundwater recharge sites throughout the County, for a not to exceed fee of \$191,000, to be funded through Flood Control District funds and establish the effective date following Board approval.

**PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION**

The purpose of the Los Angeles Basin Groundwater Recharge Study is to identify favorable groundwater recharge sites throughout the County of Los Angeles and to develop a planning device to facilitate groundwater recharge planning efforts. About a third of our local water supplies come from local groundwater sources. Identifying additional sites for recharge will help us to plan additional facilities to capture more of our local runoff and reduce our dependency on imported water sources.

### **Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals**

Awarding this contract will meet the County Strategic Plan Goal of Fiscal Responsibility and will allow Public Works to manage resources in a more efficient and responsible manner.

### **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING**

There will be no impact to the County's General Fund. Financing for the Agreement is available from the Fiscal Year 2001-02 Flood Control District fund.

The Agreement is for an aggregate not to exceed fee of \$191,000, including \$17,000 for unforeseen additional work, which may arise during progress of the work. Additional work within this allowance will not be performed without prior written authorization from the Director of Public Works.

### **FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS**

An agreement will be executed with the consultant in accordance with Public Works' standard procedures and County Code and in compliance with your Board's required provisions and legal requirements.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION**

A standard Consultant Services Agreement, previously approved as to form by County Counsel, will be used. The Agreement includes a clause for termination of services upon prior written notice and a renegotiation clause as directed by your Board.

As requested by your Board on August 12, 1997, and as a threshold requirement for consideration of contract award, CH2MHill is willing to consider Greater Avenues for Independence participants for future employment.

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CH2MHill has demonstrated satisfactory compliance with the County's Child Support Compliance Program.

### **CONTRACTING PROCESS**

On April 25, 2001, Public Works sent out Requests for Proposals (RFP) to develop select lists of engineering consultants to provide as needed services. The RFPs were sent to 29 selected firms, advertised on the County's web page, listed on the Office of Small Business website, and placed in several publications. The firms selected as the best qualified were CH2MHill, David Evans and Associates, Burns and McDonnell, Lee and Ro, and AKM Consulting Engineers.

Projects will be assigned to firms according to the select list order. Public Works is making a concerted effort to provide each firm with equitable work opportunities.

Participation by Community Business Enterprises (CBE) in the project is encouraged through Public Works' CBE Outreach Program and the requirement that consultants demonstrate their good faith efforts to utilize CBEs. CH2MHill is aware of the Public Works' CBE Outreach Program and their proposed CBE participation is on file with Public Works.

### **IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)**

There will be no negative impact on current County services or project during the performance of the recommended consultant services.
