



What is the Probation Organizational Structure and Mission Statement Mandate

It is the responsibility of the Probation Department to:

- Implement and where necessary continue to implement large-scale, complex changes
- Partner in the implementation and reform process to identify, review, deduplicate, synthesize and sequence recommendations that should lead to a comprehensive reform plan. The plan should contain timelines outcomes, metrics and key performance indicators.
- Participate in robust community engagement and communication, to enhance transparency.

What is the Probation Organizational Structure and Mission Statement Mandate

It is the responsibility of the Probation Department to:

- Have clear and well defined operational policies and procedures
- Participate in systemic reform that should result in better outcomes for juveniles and adults and
- Ensure improved transparency and public accountability.

Probation Organizational Structure

Resource Development Associates (RDA) Recommendation:

 Organize the LA Probation Department into an agency model with centralized administrative functions to support separate Juvenile and Adult client service operations

Why does this matter?

 According to the California Judicial Council Probation Services Task force, there are five principles that support a streamlined and specialized approach rather that separation

Probation: Mission Vision and Values

Resource Development Associates (RDA) Recommendation:

 Create and publish a client-focused, forward thinking mission, vision and values statement

Why does this matter?

 The mission, vision and values statement is the standard by which success is measured

Probation Mission Vision and Values

Probation Workgroup Report Recommendation (Hertz Report):

Articulate a Countywide Juvenile Justice Strategic Plan

Goal:

 Encourage transparency and accountability from all partners engaged in delinquency prevention and rehabilitation intervention services for fiscal management, measuring outcomes related to their work and implementing effective practices
