Call to Order. (16-6213)

Chairperson Bigby called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Chairperson Bigby led in the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silence.

Self-introductions were made by all in attendance.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTER

II. REPORTS

2. Department of Auditor-Controller (AC). (16-6215)

Ms. Michele Day, AC, Group Home Ombudsman, distributed copies and reported on the Children's Group Home Ombudsman Activity Report during the months of October and November 2016.

October 2016

There were a total of 18 Hotline Requests for Assistance Calls and a total there were 9 Outreach visits to the following facilities:

- **San Gabriel Children's Center (3 Sites)**
- **St. Anne's Maternity Home**
- **Children's Homes of Southern California (5 Sites)**
- **Phoenix House of Los Angeles**
- **Shouridge Group Home**
- **Hillside Home for Children (Main Campus)**

- **Field's Comprehensive Youth Services**
- **West Covina Group Home**

November 2016

In continuing her report, Ms. Day reported that in November 2016 there were a total of 23 Hotline Requests for Assistance Calls and conducted 5 Outreach visits to the following facilities:

- **Deliaann Lucile Corp.**
- **David and Margaret Home**
- **Hillsides Home for Children**
- **Murrells Farm and Boys Home**
- **Rosemary Children's Services**

3. Internal Services Department (ISD). (16-6216)

There was no representative present to report.

4. Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS). (16-6217)

Ms. Patricia Bolanos-Gonzalez, Children Services Administrator II, Out of Home Care Management Section, DCFS, reported that during the month of November 2016 there were a total of 910 Absent Without Leave (AWOLS) and the child abuse hotline received a total of 22 referrals in the following categories:

- **General Neglect (GH) – 5**
- **Physical Abuse (PA) – 6**
- **Sexual Abuse (SA) – 9**
- **Exploitation – 1**
- **Severe Neglect (SN) - 1**

Total number of referrals closed: 19

- **GN – 2**
- **PA – 6**
- **SA – 9**
- **EA (Emotional Abuse) – 2**

Investigation results of closed referrals:

- **Evaluated Out (EO) - 5**
- **Inconclusive (I) - 3**
- **Not Investigated – 4 - Two of these referrals were for Commercially Sexually Exploited Children (CSEC) and the other two were referrals generated for the replacement of youth.**
- **Unfounded – 6**
- **Substantiated (S) -1**

Ms. Bolanos-Gonzalez also reported that Olive Crest's (RCL 14) Investigative Hold was lifted on October 14, 2016. Penny Lane (RCL 12) was placed on an Investigative Hold on November 14, 2016 and the Investigative Hold was lifted on December 9, 2016.

5. Department of Mental Health (DMH). (16-6218)

Mr. Bart Callender, Residential/TBS Program Administration, DMH, reported that the DMH is in the process of working with group homes that do not hold mental health contracts to ensure that the proper mental health services are provided in group homes.

6. Probation Department (PD). (16-6219)

Mr. Michael Varela, Director of Dorothy Kirby Center, reported that Terry McDonnell has been appointed as the new Chief Probation Officer. Mr. Varela also reported that Camps Mendenhall and Scott are temporarily closed for repairs. Mr. Varela further reported that Camp

Kilpatrick has been redesigned and is scheduled to reopen in April 2017.

Ms. Mikesha Taylor, Program Analyst, PD, provided the status of group home AWOLs during the months of September, October, and November 2016 as follows:

September 2016

There were 102 AWOLs involving 86 youth:

- 40 Remain AWOL
- 49 Returned to group homes
- 12 Placed in Juvenile Hall
- 1 Child Death

October 2016

There were 106 AWOLs involving 98 youth:

- 44 Remain AWOL
- 42 Returned to group homes
- 16 Placed in Juvenile Hall
- 2 Placed in Camp
- 1 Jurisdiction Terminated
- 1 Home on Probation

November 2016

There were 119 AWOLs involving 99 youth:

- 50 Remain AWOL
- 54 Returned to group homes
- 15 Placed in Juvenile Hall

Ms. Taylor also provided the Commission with detailed monthly status reports of group home AWOLs during the months of September, October and November 2016.

7. Office of the Inspector General (OIG). (16-6220)

Ms. Stacy Nelson, OIG, introduced herself to the Commission and answered questions posed by the Commission.

8. Sheriff's Department (SD). (16-6221)

Commander Henry Romero, Los Angeles County Sheriff Department, reported that all issues that have been submitted during the December 14, 2016 visit to Twin Towers Correctional Facility have been addressed. Commander Romero also advised the Commission to immediately report future concerns to the Watch Commander on duty.

Commander Romero also answered questions posed by the Commission and informed the Commission that he will be retiring at the beginning of 2017.

9. Chairperson's Report on various items. (16-6224)

Chairperson Bigby reported that she met with Fifth District Supervisor Kathryn Barger and updated her on the work of the SBC and advised the Commissioners to meet with their Supervisors.

10. Staff Report on Correspondence Received and Department Representative Reports. (16-6222)

Staff reported that the proposed changes to the SBC Ordinance have been submitted to County Counsel for review.
