On motion of Vice President Sara Vasquez, seconded by Commissioner Priscilla Cheng, there being no objection, Commissioner Genevieve Morrill was appointed as Secretary by the Commission.

II. PUBLIC HEARINGS

3. Hearing on application for Water Taxi Operator, Business License ID# 143674, to issue a new license to Aleksei Aleksandrov for West Coast Sailing, LLC / DBA Marina Sailing, located at 4170 Admiralty Way #116, Marina Del Rey, CA 90292 in the Fourth District. (17-1171)

Eric Barnes, Treasurer and Tax Collector's Office (TTC), reported on the application for Water Taxi Operator, to issue a new license to Aleksei Aleksandrov for West Coast Sailing, LLC / DBA Marina Sailing and noted the applicant has obtained all the necessary County approvals. TTC had no objection to the issuance of a new license.

In response to questions posed by the Commission, Mr. Aleksandrov reported the business is mainly a sailing school that also charters their boats to members of their sailing club. There is a \$295.00 initiation fee followed by a \$45.00 monthly membership fee. The company has 25 active members with approximately 10,000 inactive members in six locations. Sailing classes are given on an as needed basis. New students build confidence sailing levels that move them up to run vessels up to 40 feet.

During further discussion, there were discrepancies on services that were being provided by the business regarding alcohol and catered food for promotional specials such as a Valentine's Day cruise that included a Mamosa brunch and catered food.

After further discussion, on motion of Commissioner Rochelle A. Gonzalez, seconded by Secretary Genevieve Morrill, this item was continued one week to April 12, 2017 to allow the applicant an opportunity to confirm a request for a Public Eating license and requirements for a license with the Alcohol and Beverage Control or provide the Commission with the needed changes to their company advertisement and promotional programs.

4. Hearing on application for Massage Parlor-General, Business License ID# 142725, to issue a new license to Li Chen for Massage on Colima, located at 18309 Colima Road, Rowland Heights, CA 91748, in the Fourth District. (17-1350)

They have three massage rooms with no doors. Laundry is done on site and is located in a back room within the establishment.

They serve Americana type foods.
