2. Hearing on application for Water Taxi Operator, Business License ID# 143813, to issue a new license to John D. Feldheim for JDF Ventures, LLC, located at 333 West Washington Boulevard, #150, Marina del Rey, CA 90292 in the Third District. (17-1950)

**Nicole Love, Treasurer and Tax Collector's Office (TTC), reported on the application for Water Taxi Operator, to issue a new license to John D. Feldheim of JDF Ventures, LLC, and noted the applicant has obtained all the necessary County approvals. TTC had no objection to the issuance of a new license.**

**In response to questions posed by the Commission, John D. Feldheim, owner and Captain of the vessel named Marsea, provided an overview of his business. The boat is a catamaran type weather vessel, 32 foot long and 13 foot wide, and that carries a maximum of six passengers. No food or beverages are served on the boat; however, passengers are allowed to bring their own food aboard. Captain Feldheim spent approximately 750 days at sea since 2006 to obtain the required training to become a 100 Ton Master Captain and to understand the needs of maintaining a boat. Currently, he does not have a crew; however, drug testing will be required of all possible applicants prior to employment with his company. Pictures and price lists were submitted to the Commission.**

**After discussion, on motion of Secretary Genevieve Morrill, seconded by Commissioner Priscilla Cheng, and unanimously carried, this item was approved with the following vote:**
