2. Hearing on application for Massage Parlor-General, Business License ID#144225, to issue a new license to Jinfeng Zuo for A Massage, located at 5615 Whittier Boulevard, Unit F, Los Angeles, CA 90022 in the First District. (17-2228)

Eric Barns, Treasurer and Tax Collector's Office (TTC), reported on the application for Massage Parlor-General, to issue a new license to Jinfeng Zuo, and noted the applicant has obtained all the necessary County approvals. TTC had no objection to the issuance of a new license.

Ms. Xiadei Wang, translator for Jinfeng Zuo, owner of A Massage, responded to questions posed by the Commission. The hours of operation are seven days a week from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. They have six rooms with no locks and four massage chairs. She has a total of four licensed massage therapists. They offer Chinese type massages and foot massages. She understood the Conditional Use Permit (CUP) would expire in 2020 and that she would need to file with the Regional Planning Department early to ensure operation of his business continues. The business provides four different types of cruises: A two-hour harbor cruise inside the marina, a three-hour Santa Monica cruise, a four-hour Malibu cruise, and an all-day cruise to Catalina Island.
