Ellis Everett, Treasurer and Tax Collector, stated that there are no objections from the City of Santa Clarita and the applicant has obtained all proper permits from city of Santa Clarita. Timothy Borrueal, owner, provided a brief background of the business. The academy is a private elementary school with grades K-6th. The school hours are from 8:05 a.m to 3:30 p.m. Early morning care is offered from 6:30 a.m to 8:05 a.m. and after school care is offered from 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. There are currently 348 students enrolled in the academy and there are two classes per grade. There are 3 administrators, fourteen credentialed teachers, fourteen assistant teachers with Bachelor degrees, and 5 enrichment teachers.

Ellis Everett, Treasurer and Tax Collector's Department, reported that the applicant has obtained all necessary County and Sheriff Department approvals. The business employees two people, including Ms. Masermsin, business owner. There are four client rooms at the business used for facials and deep tissue massages. The business is opened six days a week and closed on Sundays. Ms. Masermsin understands and agrees to all conditions imposed by the Sheriff's Department.

Application for Taxicab License Modification/Rate Increase

Ellis Everett, Treasurer and Tax Collector's Department, reported that the applicant has applied for a rate increase and to add four vehicles to their fleet in areas 10a and 10b. Mr. Everett also reported that the Los Angeles County Chief Executive Office, Risk Management Branch has signed off on the vehicles and there are no objections on file.

Nicholas Spirtos, Attorney at Law, representing Mr. Karame, stated that Malibu Yellow Cab covers the City of Malibu, and unincorporated areas of Malibu and Augora Hills, which also includes 27 miles of coastline in Malibu. There are other cab companies that are licensed to do pickups in the same areas but there is a lack of interest to provide service to such a broad area. Mr. Spirtos also stated that Malibu Yellow Cab Company has not had a rate increase since 1999. He also provided the Commission with a call list of statistics for the last years showing the numerous calls for services that had to be referred to outside cab companies.

Malibu Yellow Cab has a separate contract with city of Malibu Dial- a- Ride program to provide shared rides for seniors and disabled adults to medical appointment from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m..The fee increase being requested will not affect the Dial-a- Ride fees.

ACTION TAKEN: The Commission approved the following modification/rate increase:

- Flag Drop \$ 3.00 first 1/10 mile or 36 seconds
- Additional Mile \$.30 each 1/10 mile or 36 seconds thereafter
- Waiting Time per Hour \$.30 for 36 second waiting time or traffic delay

Motion: President Afriat, seconded by Vice President Campbell.

Vote: Unanimously carried

ACTION TAKEN: The Commission approved an additional 4 vehicles to the existing fleet servicing areas 10a and 10b.

Motion: President Afriat, seconded by Secretary Wood


Vote: Unanimously carried
