Request of Virginia Lopez to continue Probation Department funding for the High Risk Offender Program and school district prevention program.

Request of District Attorney Ira Reiner and Dan Murphy to restore juvenile court funding for two prosecutors per juvenile court; also funding for four deputies previously funded by the Federal Government for major narcotic prosecution; and two full time Deputy District Attorney's for legal assistance with a Countywide Crime Task Force.

Statement of Leon Spaugy, Agricultural Commissioner/ Director of Weights and Measures, regarding unmet needs of his Department.

Statement of The Honorable Rand Schrader, Chairman of the Los Angeles County Commission on AIDS, regarding AIDS funding in the Health Services Department's Budget.
