At its meeting held June 23, 1998, the Board took the following action:

At the time and place regularly set, notice having been duly given, the following item was called up:

Hearing on: a) an increase in Parks and Recreation golf greens fees of \$2.00 for 18-hole regulation weekend play and \$1.00 for 18-hole regulation weekday play and other greens fees proportionately; and an increase in all fees that include payment for staff time to reflect approved salary increases; b) restructuring departmental adult sports league fees as a range, including optional items; and the restructuring of indoor facility rental fees; c) establishment of fees for the BMX race track and reestablishment of vehicle entry fees for Area "D" at Whittier Narrows Recreation Center; and d) elimination of the combined vehicle/boat annual permit, effective July 1, 1998; also authorize the Director of Parks and Recreation to temporarily discount golf greens fees at individual courses up to 25% whenever playing conditions are adversely affected by construction, partial facility closures (e.g. temporary greens) or damages such as those caused by inclement weather or fungus, as further described in the attached letter dated June 23, 1998 from the Director of Parks and Recreation.

Opportunity was given for opponents and proponents to address the Board. No interested persons addressed the Board.

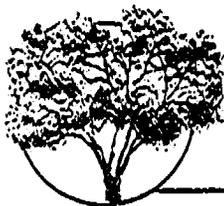
On motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Yaroslavsky, unanimously carried (Supervisors Molina and Knabe being absent), the hearing was closed and the Board took the following actions:

- a. Made a finding that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act;
- b. Adopted the attached resolution to revise the following Parks and Recreation fees, effective July 1, 1998 to:
  1. Increase golf greens fees \$2.00 for 18-hole regulation weekend play and \$1.00 for 18-hole regulation weekday play and other greens fees proportionately; and increase all fees that include payment for staff time to reflect approved salary increases;
  2. Restructure departmental adult sports league fees as a range, including optional items; and restructure indoor facility rental fees;
  3. Establish fees for the BMX race track and reestablish vehicle entry fees for Area "D" at Whittier Narrows Recreation Center; and
  4. Eliminate the combined vehicle/boat annual permit, effective July 1, 1998; and
- c. Authorized the Director of Parks and Recreation to temporarily discount golf greens fees at individual courses up to 25% whenever playing conditions are adversely affected by construction, partial facility closures (e.g. temporary greens) or damages such as those caused by inclement weather or fungus.

**APPROVAL OF  
DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION  
REVISED FEES AND CHARGES  
(All Districts - 3-Vote Matter)**

**IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD AFTER THE PUBLIC HEARING:**

1. Find that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080 (b) (8).
2. Adopt the attached resolution to revise various parks and recreation fees effective July 1, 1998, to:
  - a. increase golf greens fees, generally consisting of a \$2 increase in 18-hole regulation weekend play and a \$1 increase in 18-hole regulation weekday play and other greens fees proportionately; and increase all fees that include payment for staff time to reflect approved salary increases; and
  - b. restructure departmental adult sports league fees as a range, including optional items; and restructure indoor facility rental fees; and
  - c. establish fees for the BMX race track; and reestablish vehicle entry fees for Area "D" at Whittier Narrows Recreation Center; and
  - d. eliminate the combined vehicle/boat annual permit.
3. Authorize the Director of Parks and Recreation to temporarily discount golf greens fees at individual courses up to 25 percent whenever playing conditions are adversely affected by construction, partial facility closures (e.g., temporary greens) or damages such as those caused by inclement weather or fungus.

### **PURPOSE OF RECOMMENDED ACTION**

This department has completed its annual review of parks and recreation fees in accordance with a 1980-81 Grand Jury recommendation. The most recent surveys and cost analyses indicate that additional adjustments to the department's Schedule of Fees and Charges are warranted, as outlined in Attachment I. In accordance with Section 50402 of the Government Code, these changes must be approved by a resolution of your Board.

### **JUSTIFICATION**

The proposed revisions are necessary to maintain comparability with other agencies and to cover cost increases, including wages, that have occurred since October 1, 1997, which is the date this department implemented its last comprehensive revision of fees and charges.

The delegation of authority to the Director of Parks and Recreation to temporarily discount golf greens fees will allow the department to address short-term problems that affect the quality of play at individual facilities.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The increase in golf greens fees will generate approximately \$500,000 in annual revenue, which has been included in the department's 1998-99 revenue estimates and is targeted for 14 additional Recreation Services positions in the department's proposed Fiscal Year 1998-99 budget.

The establishment of BMX racing fees at Whittier Narrows Recreation Area will generate approximately \$46,000 in annual revenue. The anticipated revenue generated from this fee has been included in the department's 1998-99 revenue estimates and will offset the department's costs associated with operating the facility.

All other fee changes or increases will not generate significant additional revenue for the department, and are being increased solely to offset increases in departmental operating costs.

### **FINANCING**

Not applicable.

### **FACTS AND PROVISIONS/ LEGAL REQUIREMENTS**

The various recommended changes to the current schedule of fees and charges represent increases, restructuring, and establishment of new fees as follows:

Increases

Golf greens fees will be increased by \$1 for weekday 18-hole regulation play and \$2 for weekend 18-hole regulation play. Other golf greens fees will be increased proportionately, except for the 9-hole regulation courses, at which no increase is suggested in order maintain or increase the current number of rounds played. This increase will provide funding for 14 additional Recreation Services positions in the department.

Some fees will be increased to offset staff costs which have increased as a result of the recent Board-approved salary increases. Fees for the following categories will be increased, effective July 1, 1998, upon approval by your Board:

Non-Department Sports Activities

Softball & Baseball Field Permits  
Soccer Field Permits  
Field Preparation

Assignment of Staff

Recreation Services Leader  
Grounds Maintenance Worker  
Senior Pool Lifeguard  
Lake Lifeguard  
Senior Lake Lifeguard

Restructured Fees

Departmental league fees are being restructured as a range to include previously "optional" items. These "optional" items include awards and trophies, umpires or officials, play equipment and a refundable bond. In addition, the range allows for variation in the number of games, playoff structure and levels of services.

Indoor facility rental fees are being restructured as \$25 per hour with a four hour minimum for rooms with a capacity of 150 persons and as \$37.50 per hour with a four hour minimum for a room with a capacity over 150 persons. The current indoor facility rental fees are \$100 for four hours and \$200 all day for a room with a capacity of 150 persons and \$150 for four hours and \$300 all day for a room with a capacity of over 150 persons. The restructured fee will allow greater flexibility in providing indoor facility rentals.

The department is also recommending the elimination of the combined vehicle/boat annual permit. Patrons instead will buy separate vehicle and boat permits, allowing patrons to use their vehicles at County facilities that assess a vehicle entry fee without having to bring along the boat, to which the combined annual permit is affixed. In addition, the separate permits will allow patrons to enter all facilities that charge a vehicle entry fee, and not only those that also offer boating activities.

New Fees

In Fiscal Year 1997-98, the Department of Parks and Recreation assumed responsibility for operation of the BMX race track at Whittier Narrows Recreation Area, which had previously been operated by a lessee. In view of the department's

assumption of responsibility, the fees charged at the race track require your Board's approval. Upon approval by your Board, fees for the BMX race track at Whittier Narrows Recreation Area will be established at a rate of \$3 per person for practice use, \$9 per person for race participation and a range not to exceed \$5 per person for tournament registration. These fees for practice and race participation are consistent with those that the former lessee charged for use of the facility.

Additionally, a vehicle entry fee of \$3 will be reestablished for parking area "D" at Whittier Narrows Recreation Area.

#### Delegation of Authority

It is recommended that your Board delegate to the Director of Parks and Recreation the authority to temporarily discount golf fees by up to 25 percent at individual courses whenever playing conditions are adversely affected by construction, partial facility closures (e.g. temporary greens) or damages such as those caused by inclement weather or fungus. This delegated authority would allow the department to address temporary problems affecting the quality of play at individual facilities. For example, the Diamond Bar Golf Course greens sustained flood damage because of the El Niño storms, resulting in the use of several temporary greens.

Public hearing notice requirements of Government Code Section 6062(a) have been satisfied and public hearing requirements of Government Code Section 66018 will be satisfied by this action.

The Park and Recreation Commission reviewed and approved these recommended actions. County Counsel has approved the attached Resolution as to form.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT/ NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The proposed fee changes and increases are for the purpose of (1) meeting operating expenses, including employee wage rates and fringe benefits, or (2) purchasing and leasing supplies, equipment or materials, or (3) meeting financial reserve needs and requirements and, therefore, the proposed actions are exempt for the California Environmental Quality Act, pursuant to Section 21080(b)(8) of the Public Resources Code.

#### IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

The increases are not anticipated to have a significant impact on the use of the affected facilities.

**RESOLUTION TO INCREASE AND OTHERWISE REVISE VARIOUS PARKS AND RECREATION FEES**

WHEREAS, the County's park facilities offer services and recreational opportunities similar to other facilities at which these fees are collected; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the fees collected at the County's golf courses will be deposited into Special Development Funds for further expansion and improvement at the facilities generating the monies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, has found it reasonable and necessary to eliminate the combined vehicle/boat annual permit, establish new fees for the BMX race track and parking area "D" at Whittier Narrows Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, County regional park facility fees are not in excess of 125 percent of similar fees charged by the State Department of Parks and Recreation for the use of State facilities; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the fees collected at the County regional park facilities will be deposited into the Special Development Fund-Regional Parks for further development and improvements at the facilities generating the monies; and

WHEREAS, these costs do not exceed the cost of the services provided by the County Department of Parks and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, these increases will help offset operating costs; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding is in the public interest and welfare; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 50402, the County has the authority to charge for use of park and recreational facilities as provided by resolution of the governing body; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, State of California as follows:

The County Department of Parks and Recreation may make the adjustments to golf greens fees, and park and recreation fees and charges, as outlined in Attachment I hereto.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted on the 23rd day of June, 1998, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles and ex-officio the governing body of all other special assessment and taxing districts, agencies and authorities for which said Board so acts.
