At its meeting held July 13, 1993, the Board took the following action:

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Supervisor Antonovich made the following statement:

"At its April 27, 1993, meeting, the Board of Supervisors requested the Chief Administrative Officer, in concert with the Superior and Municipal Courts, Marshal, Sheriff and other affected Departments to review the potential for additional revenues from outstanding, unserved arrest warrants in Los Angeles County. The Chief Administrative Officer reported to the Board on several ways to improve the current collections process."

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Edelman, unanimously carried (Supervisor Molina being absent), the Board instructed the Chief Administrative Officer to:

1. Develop a plan to implement Countywide use of credit/debit cards for payment of fines and penalty assessments and other cases eligible for cost recovery;

2. Intensify the efforts to initiate collection services, including use of collection agencies, for Courts which do not currently have them; and
3. Report back to the Board on the progress of these directives within 21 days.

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
