On June 24, 2015, Long Beach patrol officers were dispatched to the alley rear of 1175 East 21st Street in the City of Long Beach regarding a female down. Upon their arrival they discovered a young female adult who sustained several gunshots to her upper torso. The victim, who was later identified as 21-year-old Alicia Todd, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Homicide investigators were called to the scene and started the investigation. Detectives learned Todd was last seen at her home in Signal Hill preparing to go to bed.

Investigators have canvassed the neighborhood looking for witnesses to the incident and feel they are at a point where it would be beneficial to offer a reward, which may prompt reluctant witnesses to come forward and provide information to identify the individuals responsible for this crime

**I, THEREFORE MOVE** that the Board of Supervisor offer a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s) of this heinous crime.
