At its meeting held January 27, 2004, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Antonovich made the following statement:

“Transferring his talents and energies from the motion picture industry to public service, Ronald Reagan brought to the halls of government graciousness, dignity, and a determination to improve our nation and preserve liberty for people worldwide. Employing old-fashioned common sense and hope, Governor Reagan brought California back from the brink of bankruptcy to restore its greatness and the faith of its people in good government. Known as the Great Communicator, President Reagan’s leadership led to the collapse of the Berlin Wall and paved the way for the dismantling of the Soviet Union.

“As his health declined, he shared with his fellow Americans the news of his illness, increasing awareness and financial support for Alzheimer’s research.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, unanimously carried (Supervisor Yaroslavsky being absent), the Board proclaimed February 6, 2004 as “President Ronald Reagan Day” throughout Los Angeles County in recognition of his 93rd birthday.
