**RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING  
2016-17 GRANT AWARDS FOR CULTURAL SERVICES  
(ALL DISTRICTS) (3 VOTES)**

**SUBJECT**

The County, through the Los Angeles County Arts Commission, provides grants to nonprofit arts organizations to deliver a wide variety of cultural services to County residents. Grants for concerts, theatre productions, exhibitions, in-school and out of school arts education programs and core operations provide access to the arts for residents throughout the County.

**IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:**

1. Approve the recommendations of the Arts Commission for the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Organizational Grant Program (OGP) for grants to 205 nonprofit arts organizations at a cost of \$4,518,000, as such grants help to meet the social needs of constituents by fostering excellence, diversity, vitality, understanding and accessibility of the arts in Los Angeles County.
2. Instruct the Arts Commission Executive Director to prepare, sign and execute these contracts after County Counsel approves as to form.
3. Delegate authority to the Arts Commission to reallocate forfeited grant awards, not to exceed \$100,000 in aggregate, to existing Board-approved grantee organizations and instruct the Arts Commission Executive Director to amend these contracts accordingly.

**PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION**

The purpose of this recommended action is to disburse grant funds allocated by your Board. This is the annual implementation of the Organizational Grant Program (OGP). All organizations apply for two years of consecutive funding and all award amounts are for two years. The number of recommended grantees in 2016-17 is 205.

**Organizational Grant Program 1/Small Budget Organizations**

This category provides support for nonprofit arts organizations with budgets up to \$199,999 and two years of producing history. OGP 1 grant funds will be disbursed to 118 nonprofit arts organizations (see BOS Attachments Pg. 1-7) at a cost of \$1,378,300.

**Organizational Grant Program 2/Mid-Size Budget Organizations**

This category provides support for nonprofit arts organizations with budgets between \$200,000 and \$999,999. OGP 2 grant funds will be disbursed to 56 nonprofit arts organizations (see BOS Attachments Pg. 8-11) at a cost of \$1,426,500.

**Organizational Grant Program 3/Larger Mid-Size Budget Organizations**

This category provides support for nonprofit arts organizations with budgets between \$1,000,000 and \$14,999,999. OGP 3 grant funds will be disbursed to 28 nonprofit arts organizations (see BOS Attachments Pg. 12-14) at a cost of \$1,370,500.

**Organizational Grant Program 4/Large Budget Organizations**

This category provides support for nonprofit arts organizations with budgets over \$15 million, including major Los Angeles County institutions, to ensure accessibility. Grants must be used for programs that increase access to cultural services for County residents. OGP 4 grant funds will be disbursed to 3 nonprofit arts organizations (see BOS Attachments Pg. 15) at a cost of \$342,700.

The Arts Commission utilized discipline peer panels to review and score all applications and to make recommendations to the Arts Commissioners. The Arts Commissioners reviewed these scores and allocations and are submitting funding recommendations to your Board for approval.

Grant amounts are awarded utilizing a formula adopted by the Arts Commission. Awards are based upon the organization's budget size, which determines the request allowable under the guidelines. A percent of the request is then awarded based upon the score assigned it by the discipline peer panel and the Arts Commissioners. Scores are determined by evaluating the organization's artistic quality and accomplishments, quality of standards-based K-12 arts education services (if applicable), services to community/audience, evaluation methodology, and fiscal and administrative competence.

Upon notification of a forfeited FY 2016-17 OGP grant award, the Arts Commission will reallocate the forfeited funds to existing Board-approved grantee organizations. The reallocation will be approved by the Arts Commissioners.

For the Fiscal Year 2015-16, forfeited funds totaling \$61,600 from three of the 184 organizations awarded grants through the OGP were reallocated to Board-approved grantee organizations. Consistent with prior re-allocations made by the Commission, the grant dollars were reallocated to organizations from each supervisorial district in the same OGP category.

The County is authorized to contract with any firm or corporation for artistic services for the residents of Los Angeles County pursuant to Government Code sections 25562 and 26227. The contractor (grantee) will be governed by the policy and guideline requirements of the Arts Commission. Grantees are defined as nonprofit 501(c)(3) organizations with missions to provide arts services for the benefit of the public.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION**

The recommended actions are not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because they do not constitute a project according to Section 15378 of CEQA.

### **CONTRACTING PROCESS**

The County will pay the contractor (grantee), in consideration of services to be performed and fulfillment of matching requirements, a specific grant award sum (see BOS Attachments Pg. 1-15).

**IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)**

This program ensures that a wide variety of diverse cultural services will continue to reach County residents. These services will positively impact residents, neighborhoods and communities by providing direct access and increased opportunities for quality arts activities and programming that is often free or low cost. Organizations are located throughout LA County with offices in 48 of the County's 88 municipalities.
