Developing a Countywide Digital Evidence Management Strategy

Videos generated by body-worn cameras could become digital evidence that is transmitted and stored in binary form. Other sources of digital evidence include closed-circuit television videos, digital content such as Portable Document Format and Tagged Image File Format, as well as other still and moving imagery generated by mobile phones. The wide variety of digital evidence content necessitates the development of a Criminal Justice Enterprise Platform for managing the content of digital evidence.

I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

Direct the Information Systems Advisory Body in collaboration with the Executive
Director of the Countywide Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee, District Attorney,
Public Defender, Alternate Public Defender, County Counsel, Chief Executive Officer,
and other public safety and justice partners to develop an implementation strategy for a
Countywide Digital Evidence Management System based on open industry standards
and report back to the Board of Supervisors in writing in 120 days.
